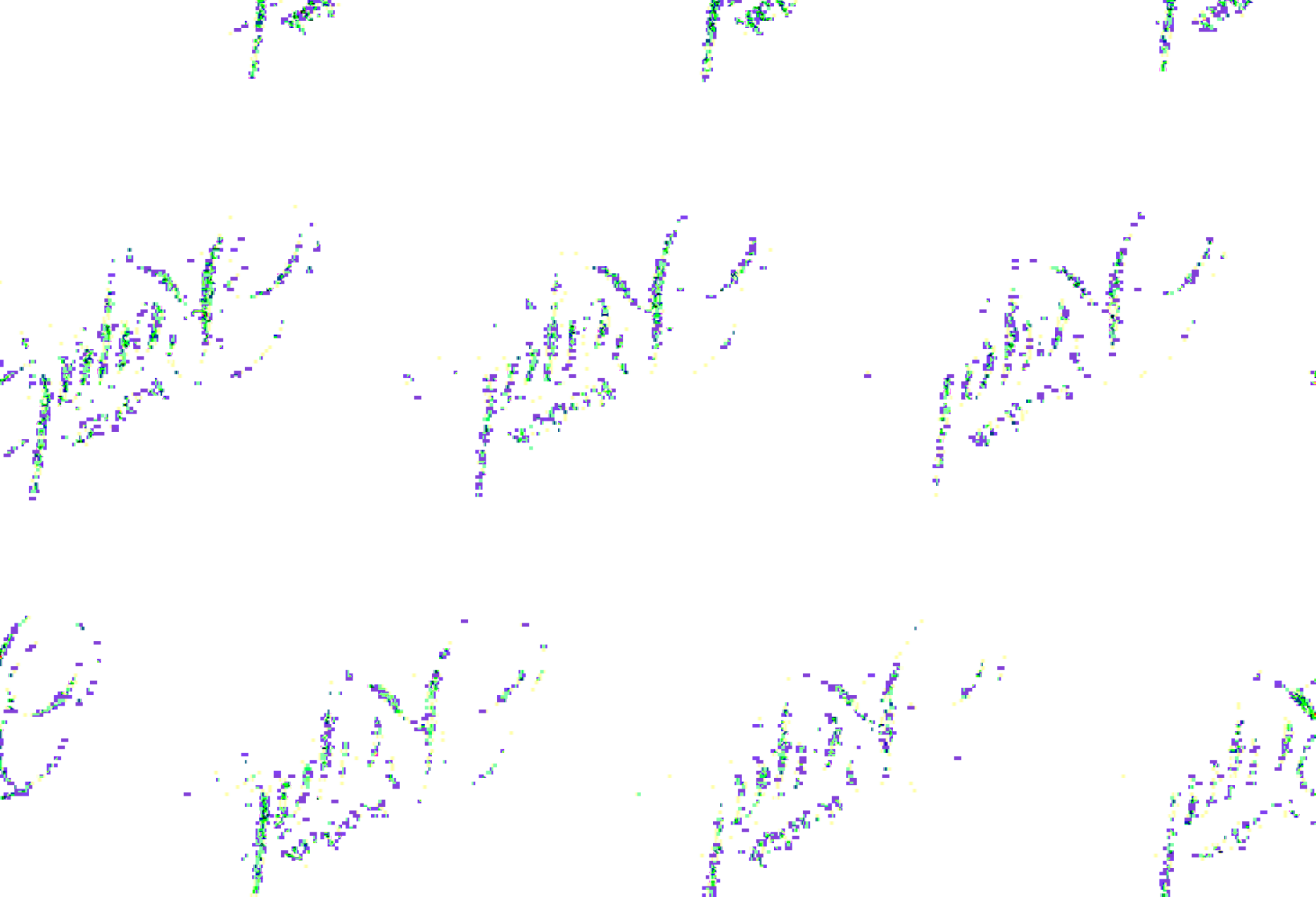

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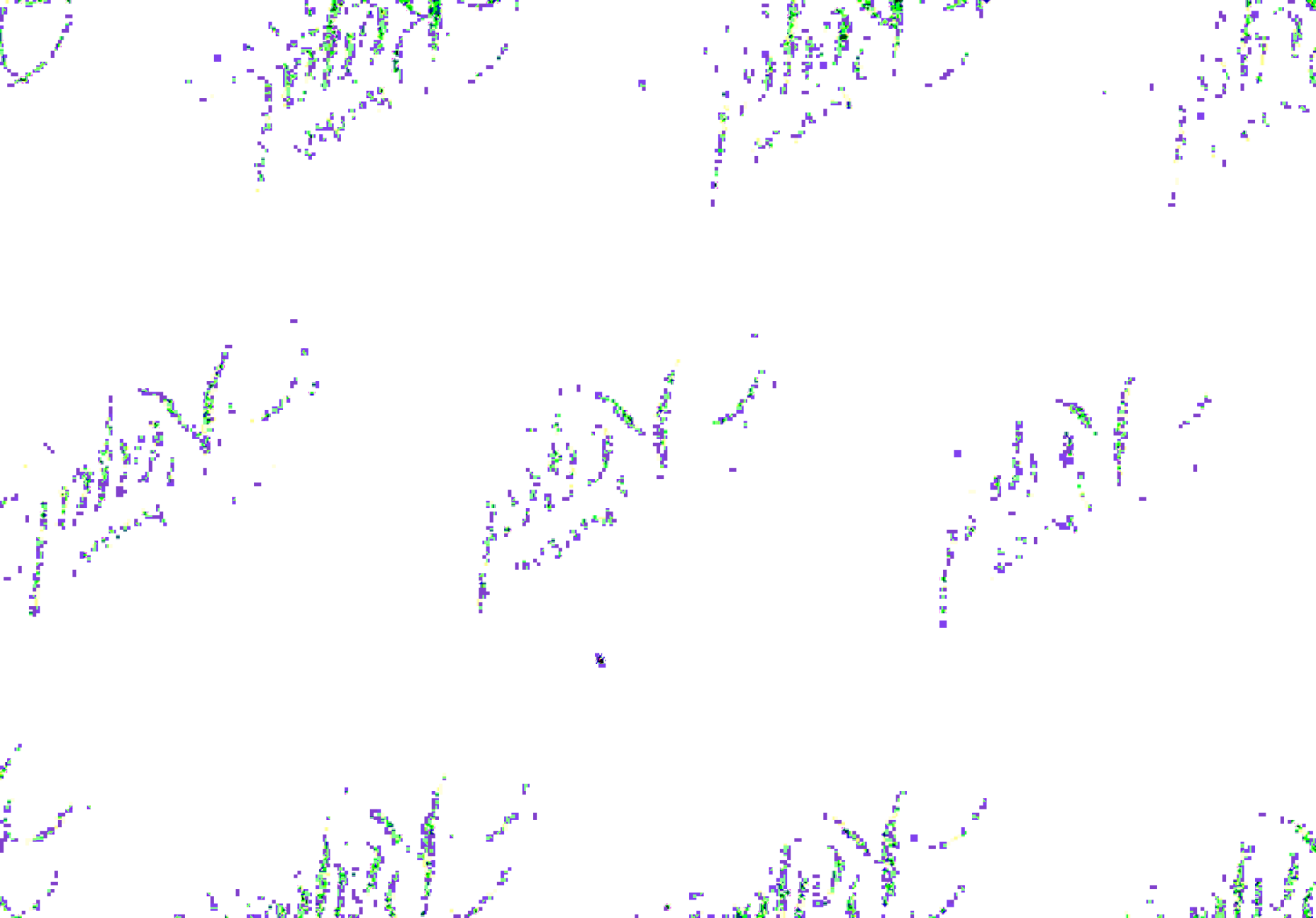
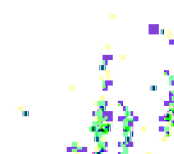




Figure 1. The effect of the concentration of the *Agaricus bisporus* spores on the growth of *Agaricus bisporus* on the substrate. The concentration of the spores was 10⁴ spores/ml (1), 10⁵ spores/ml (2), 10⁶ spores/ml (3), 10⁷ spores/ml (4), 10⁸ spores/ml (5), 10⁹ spores/ml (6), 10¹⁰ spores/ml (7), 10¹¹ spores/ml (8), 10¹² spores/ml (9), 10¹³ spores/ml (10), 10¹⁴ spores/ml (11), 10¹⁵ spores/ml (12). The growth of *Agaricus bisporus* was measured by the diameter of the mycelium (mm) after 7 days of incubation at 25 °C. The data are the mean ± SD of three replicates.

The study employs a quantitative research design, utilizing a survey of 100 participants. The data collected is analyzed using statistical methods to determine the significance of the findings.

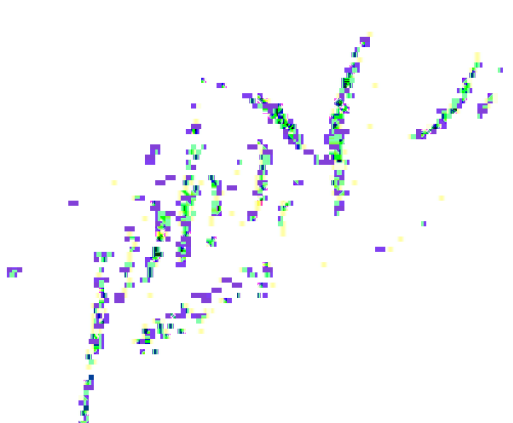
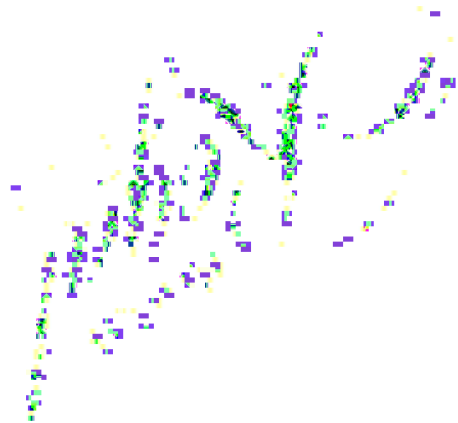
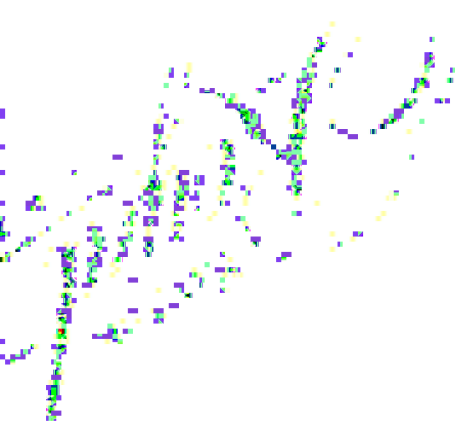
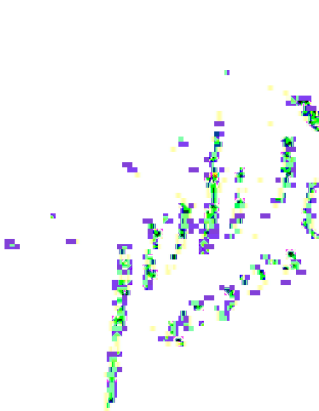
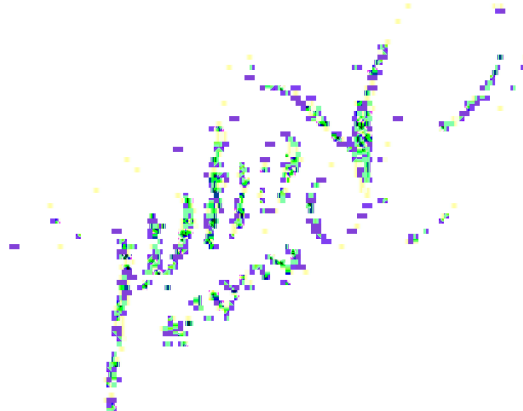
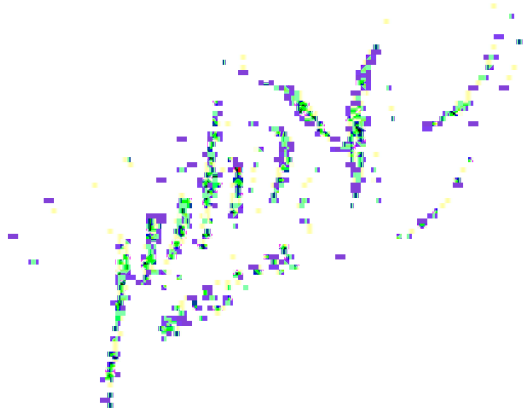
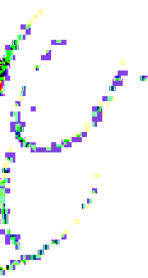
3. Results

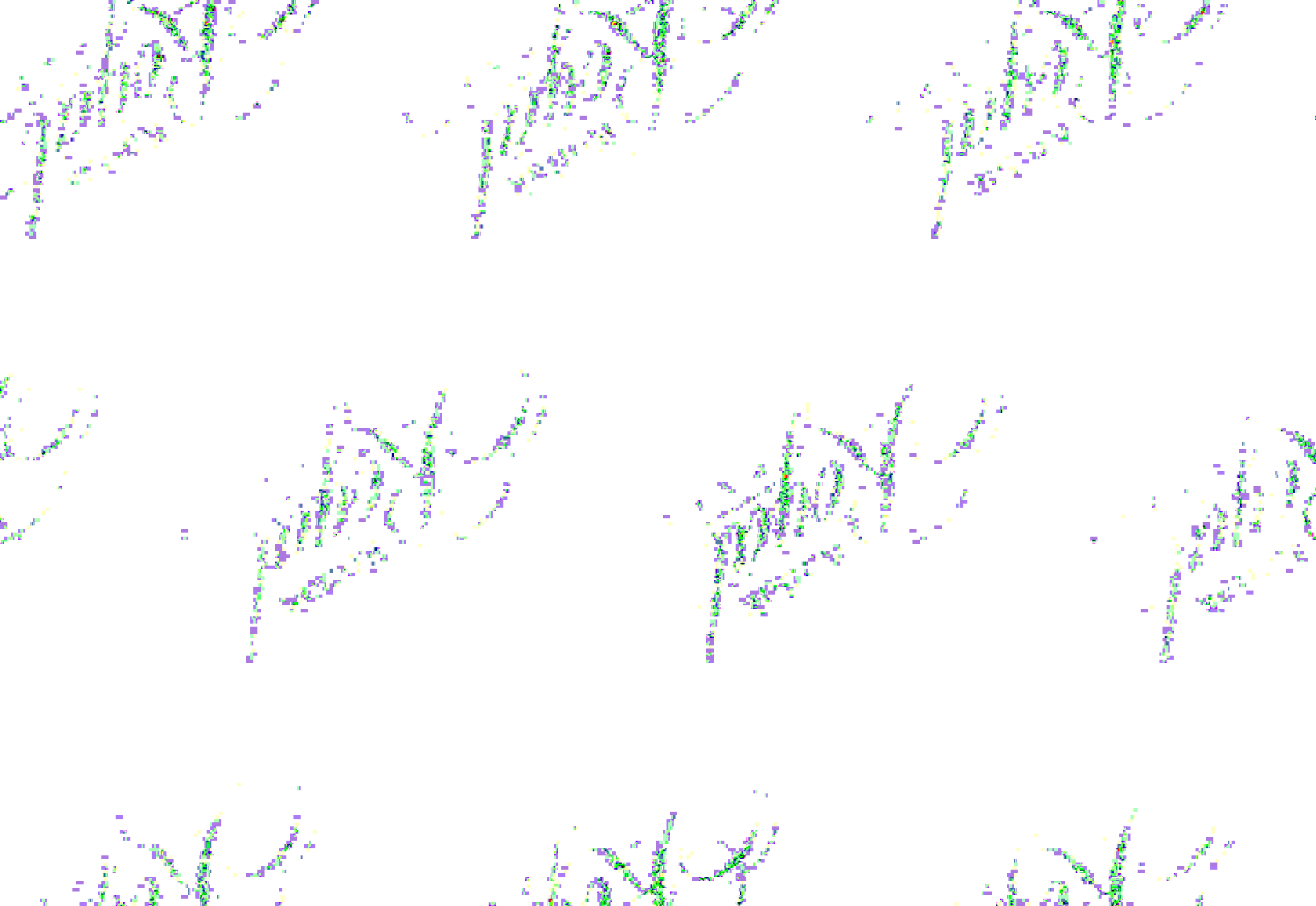

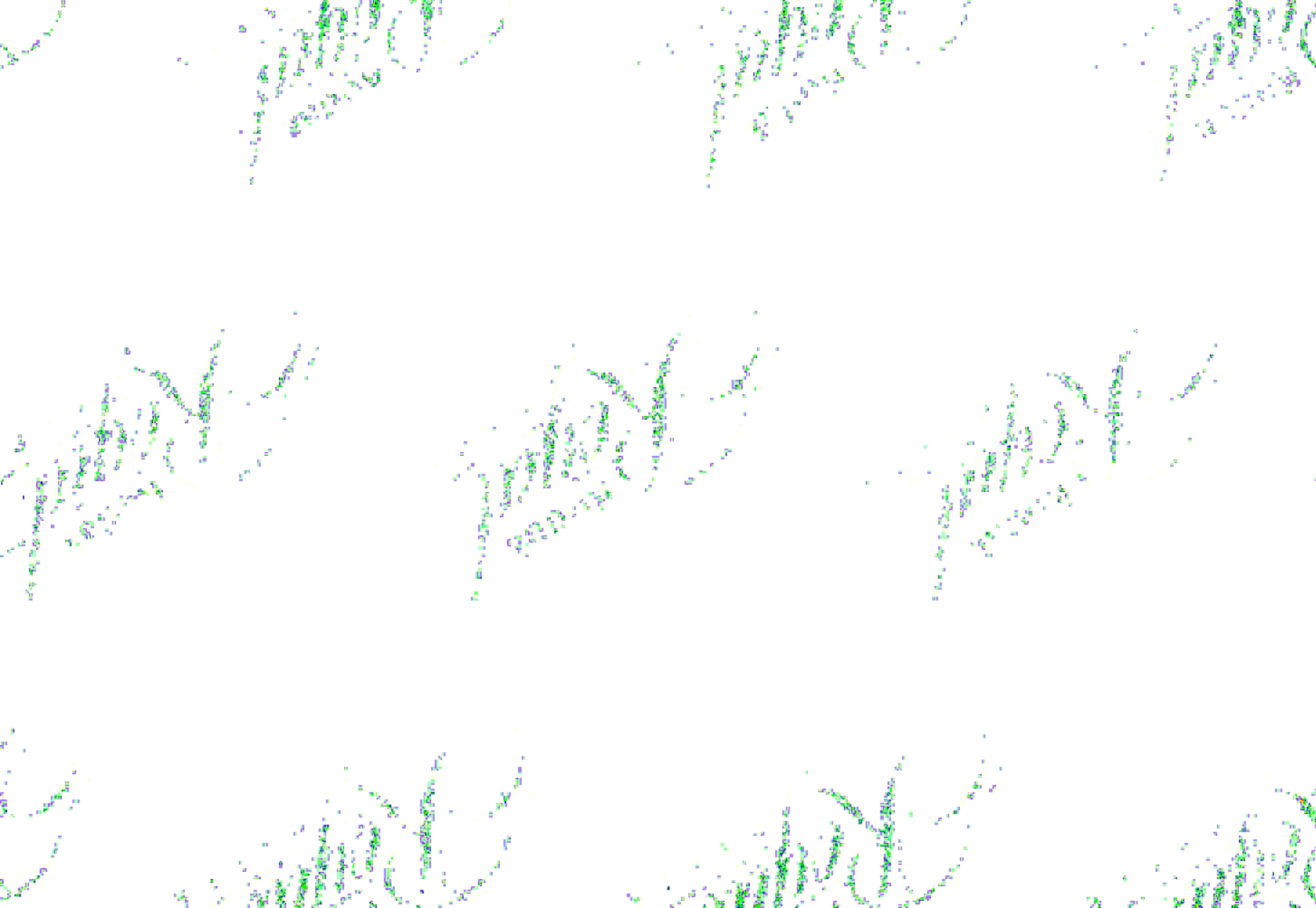

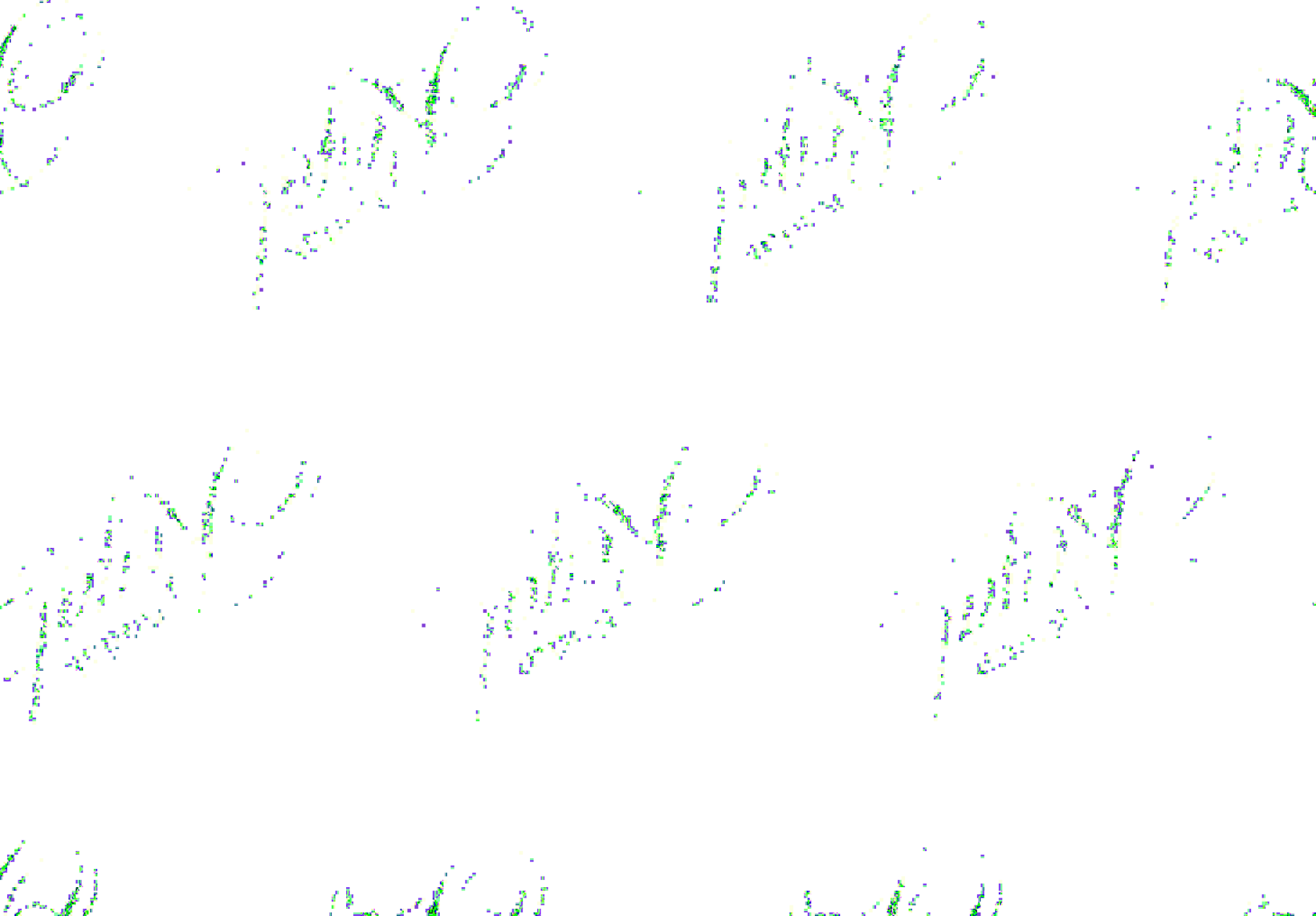
